COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SECTION

This section aims at improving the livelihood of the people through empowering of individuals, families, groups and the community with knowledge, skills, and attitude change to enable them to identify their needs and be involved in coming up with solutions that will improve the quality of their lives.

Objectives of Community Development are:

- ◆ To improve the economic well being of the people through education and commitment
- ◆ To train existing structures e.g. VDCs and enhance their capabilities in undertaking roles and tasks in their communities.
- ◆ To assist communities to identify, manage and utilize local resources for their benefit.

VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

Mandate : VDC act as the Parliament of the village by planning, coordinating and overseeing the implementation of all development activities within the Community.

VDC Initiatives: Include construction of Day Care Centres for Early Childhood Education and Job Creation, Recreational facilities like Community Halls etc.

REMOTE AREA DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

This programme is aimed at achieving sustainable Social Economic Development of people in remote areas, through a coordinated and integrated multi-sectoral approach, so that they can equally benefit from the rapid economic development of the country

RADP OBJECTIVES

- ◆ Encourage direct participation of remote communities in the development issues
- ◆ Promote development of leadership structures and representation in remote areas
- ◆ Adopt and advocate affirmative action across all sectors to provide remote communities with equal access to entitlements and promote tolerance and understanding at National Level of historically marginalized people.

TYPES OF SERVICES

- ◆ Livestock provision
- ◆ Portable water for livestock
- ◆ Construction of Kraals
- ◆ Training of individual /groups



COMMUNITY PROJECTS PROGRAMME (LG1109)

The programme is aimed at improving the socio economic status/well being of the communities by facilitating the implementation of income generating projects and provision of logistical support.

PROGRAMME (LG1109) COMPONENTS

A. Small projects: This is responsible for funding small income generating projects identified by the community. The ceiling for funding these projects is P250 000.00. Community contribution is 5% in cash or in kind of the total cost of the project. The projects include Day Care Centres, Sorghum mill, brick moulding etc.

B. Pilot component: This was introduced for purposes of funding productive and income generating activities in communities. The maximum amount that can be requested is P750 000.00

C. Training and Logistics: It aims at developing and improving project management and implementation skills of VDC members and other members of the community.

D. Block grant: P4000.00 given to a selected VDC that has proven to be active for purposes of enhancing development activities. VDC therefore have to account financially to the local authorities.

E. Vehicles: Aims at procuring vehicles to be used for field operations during project implementation. These vehicles are under the management of Councils
